GENERAL DRESS COMMENTS

Uniforms are an important aspect of St. Boniface School. They provide a sense of group identity and self-discipline, reduce distractions, eliminate competition for attention, minimize social differences, and make it easier for parents to get their children to school on time. It is impossible to list all the attire that a child may or may not wear to school; therefore, we ask your assistance in helping your child dress according to the "spirit and intent" of the dress code policy. [Clothing must be neat, without tatters, tears, or rips.](#) Anything that might detract from a positive image of the student or school is not appropriate dress. School administration retains the right to request a student to change into appropriate attire if their dress does not meet the spirit of the code/day.

On **NON-UNIFORM**, "dress down" or "special dress" days, students do not have to wear their complete uniforms; however all attire should be appropriate style and length to school. [\[Attire should be no shorter than the length of the fingertips when your arms are relaxed at your side. Blouses/tops may not have a low cut neckline or a high midsection.\]](#) [Clothing must be neat, without tatters, holes, or tears.](#) Shoes must always cover the foot. On special "dress days", they may receive specific instructions about what will be allowed and what is appropriate. Again, we request that the parents reinforce what the school tries to accomplish by pointing out to the child that dress for Six Flags, should be different from the style of dress for the St. Louis Symphony. [Students who do not appropriately follow the "dress-down" uniform will be fitted in whatever "slightly" worn uniforms that are in storage and given a dress code "check".](#)

All students will be expected to wear school uniform pants, shorts, skorts, or scooters for **PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASSES**. Girls who wear jumpers to school should wear navy blue or royal blue shorts under the jumper and then remove the jumper upon entering the gym. This is being done because of problems with the skirts getting caught under scooter wheels and because they do cause a hindrance in some activities.

Students should always dress appropriately according to the weather and be prepared **for outdoor recess**. Slacks/leggings may not be worn under jumpers/skorts during the school day; however, plain navy, black, or white tights may be worn. Jeans are not allowed without specific permission.

UNIFORM DRESS CODE

BELT: Students are required to wear a plain dark belt with slacks or shorts which have belt loops. [Students in grades 5-8 may wear a tan belt with their khaki colored pants.]

BLOUSES: Girls must wear white blouses (with or without the logo) of the following style: uniform, oxford cloth, polo with a collar, or turtleneck. [Girls in grades 5-8 may opt to wear navy blue blouses/shirts with khaki.] The blouse may be long or short sleeved. They are to be tucked in when worn with the scooter, skorts, pants, or shorts.

HAIR: Both boys' and girls' hair should always be neatly groomed and styled [so that the eyes and face are clearly visible](#). Innovative hairstyling (including coloring of the hair) is always discouraged and requires the approval of the school administrator. Boys' hair should be cut so that the ears are visible, is above the eyebrows, and may not be below the shirt collar. Boys must also be clean-shaven - no facial hair is allowed.

HATS: Students are not allowed to wear hats, caps or head coverings of any kind inside the school building.

JEANS: Denims or jeans may **NEVER** be worn as part of the school uniform.

JEWELRY: Only girls may wear small post earrings in the ear lobe only. For safety reasons, they should not wear dangle earrings.

JUMPER: Jumpers may be worn by the girls in Grade K-4. They may be purchased from **Fischer's Uniform, Style # 162** or from **French Toast, Style # 1047**.

MAKEUP: Makeup is not permitted for any grade level during school hours and most school sponsored extra curricular activities. "Light" make-up may be worn on "special and specific" occasions.

NAIL POLISH: Nail polish is discouraged. If worn, it must be of one color and must be neatly maintained.

SHIRTS: Boys must wear shirts (with or without the logo) of the following types: uniform, oxford cloth, polo with a collar, or turtleneck. The shirts may be long or short sleeved. They must be tucked in when worn with the slacks or shorts. Boys in grades K –4 wear light blue or white. In addition to light blue and white, boys in grades 5 –8 may wear navy blue with khaki colored pants.

SHOES: Students must wear shoes that completely cover the foot. The shoes should be of one solid color, contain little trimming or design, and be primarily blue, black, white, or gray to match the school uniform colors. [Dress boots, sandals, platform shoes, high heels, or wheelie shoes of any type are not allowed.] Shoes are to be appropriately laced with plain laces and tightly tied. [Both laces are expected to be the same color.] Snow boots may be worn for outdoor recess during the winter months, but may not be worn throughout the day in the classroom.

Tennis shoes are required for P.E. and recess, and only **NON-MARRING** tennis shoes are allowed in the gym. To avoid marring the gym floor, parents should avoid buying black-soled gym shoes. Tennis shoes which have thick soles are not allowed in P.E. or on the playground because they have no flex when the students run and can be dangerous.

SHORTS: All students may wear shorts from the first day of school until October 15th; and from April 15th until the end of the school year. Shorts are to be navy blue cotton/polyester. [Students in grades 5-8 may opt to wear khaki colored shorts.] The shorts must be a walking short style with a long leg that comes close to the knee. [[They should be no shorter than the length of the fingertips when your arms are relaxed at your side.](#)] The style may be either the flat front or pleated similar to our uniform slacks. No P.E. style shorts, denim, or shorts with pockets on the legs may be worn.

CULOTTES/SCOOTER/ SKORTS: These may be worn by girls throughout the school year. They must be the designated styled uniform as listed below. Girls in grades K-4 wear St. Boniface blue/red plaid. Girls in Grades 5-8 wear skorts/scooters of khaki or navy blue color.

Culotte Purchases made from Fischers should be of the Royal Park Uniforms brand--Style #140.

☺ Grades K- 4 culotte = St. Boniface Plaid

Scooter/Skort Purchases made from French Toast should be:

☺ Grades K –4 skort = **Style # 1068** in Blue/Red plaid

☺ **Grades K – 4 Plaid Two Tab Scooter = Style 1397 B** in Blue/Red Plaid

☺ Grades 5-8 skort = **Style # 1070** in either navy or khaki

☺ **Grades 5-8 "Two Tab" scooter =Style # 1302** in either navy or khaki

SLACKS: All students may wear slacks throughout the school year. Slacks are to be navy blue in color and made of cotton/polyester (twill). [Students in grades 5-8 may opt to wear khaki colored slacks.] The style may be the flat front or pleated front. Slacks are to be “plain” in nature with no pockets or other decorations on the pants. Corduroys, denims, jeans, sweatpants, jogging pants, stirrup, and other stretch pants are not allowed.

SOCKS: All students must wear either solid navy blue or white socks with no logos. Socks must be clearly visible to others/teachers. Girls may wear anklets, knee socks, or navy, black, or white tights with a skort or jumper. [Leggings may not be worn during the school day.]

SWEATERS: A navy blue or white sweater may be worn with the jumper, slacks, or skort (girls) or with the slacks or shorts (boys). The sweater may be long sleeved; a crew neck or V-neck pullover; or a cardigan sweater. They may have a small brand name, emblem, or monogram, but that is to be the only deviation; otherwise, they should be plain. Sweaters should not be grossly oversized.

SWEATSHIRTS: **Only** Navy or Royal blue sweatshirts with the “approved” St. Boniface Logo may be worn. Sweatshirts should not be grossly oversized. [Band students may wear their band sweatshirts on band days.] Sweatshirts may be purchased from Fischers Uniforms.

T-SHIRTS: T shirts worn under the school uniform shirt should be a solid white. No writing/color/design should be showing.

Dress Code Violations

A student in violation of the dress code will be asked to correct the problem immediately, if possible. (Example: Please tuck in your shirt.) Other violations may require a phone call to the parents to bring the correct clothing; or the student may be asked to put on a “slightly worn” clothing item from our storage. Student violations will be logged. A student with 4 dress code violations will not be permitted to “dress down” on the next non-uniform day; or **in some situations, a detention may be given.**
